Access to clean energy, Zero-carbon electricity generation, Energy efficiency, Electrification and zero-carbon fuels, Curbing pollution

#### 4. Sustainable Food, Land, Water and Oceans

Efficient and resilient agricultural systems, Protection of terrestrial and marine biodiversity, Healthy food promotion and regulation, Trade and supply chains consistent with sustainable Development, Integrated landuse and water management

#### 5. Sustainable Cities and Communities

Urban access to water, sanitation, and waste management, Sustainable mobility and transport networks, More compact settlements, Urban adaptation and resilience
